ADVISORY

Advisory is the heart of all programming at New Village. A student's advisor manages and supports her project and her progress toward graduation. An advisor is an academic, social, and emotional support and the primary point of contact for students and guardians with the school.

ASESORIA (ADVISORY)

La asesoría es el corazón de todos los programas en New Village. El/la asesor/a de cada estudiante apoya y guía su proyecto y progreso hacia la graduación. El/la asesor/a brinda apoyo académico, social y emocional, y es el punto principal de contacto entre la escuela, los estudiantes y sus familias.

WELLNESS PROGRAMMING

We host monthly Wellness Days, where staff and students engage in fun workshops and off-campus events. Student also participate in two dedicated times each day for guided meditation practices to promote self-care.

PROGRAMACION DE BIENESTAR

CALIFORNIA SCIENCE CENTER

We partner with the California Science Center to meet students' Science course requirements. On Wednesday mornings, students ride a bus to the California Science Center campus and participate in Biology, Chemistry, Space Science, or Environmental Science courses. Students have access to state-of-the-art facilities and materials in this program!

CENTRO DE CIENCIA DE CALIFORNIA

Nos asociamos con el California Science Center para cumplir con los requisitos de los cursos de ciencias. Los miércoles por la mañana, los estudiantes viajan en autobús al centro y participan en clases de Biología, Química, Ciencias del Espacio o Ciencias Ambientales. ¡Los estudiantes tienen acceso a instalaciones y materiales de última generación en este programa!

ATTENDANCE POLICY

Attendance is taken daily at 8:30am. If a student is absent from school, their guardian will be contacted by phone at 9:00am. Some absences can be "excused." Examples of excused absences: Sick, medical appointment, funeral, court date. Proper documentation is required to be sent to the front office. Unexcused absences are different. If a student has three unexcused absences, a home visit will be conducted. If a student has 10 unexcused absences in a row, they will be dropped from school.

POLIZA DE ASISTENCIA

La asistencia se toma todos los días a las 8:30 a.m. Si un estudiante está ausente, se llamará a su padre/tutor legal a las 9:00 a.m. Algunas ausencias pueden considerarse "justificadas", como enfermedad, citas médicas, funeral o cita en la corte. Se debe entregar documentación a la oficina principal. Las ausencias injustificadas son diferentes. Si un estudiante tiene tres ausencias injustificadas, se realizará una visita domiciliaria. Si acumula 10 ausencias injustificadas consecutivas, será dada de baja de la escuela.

COLLEGE AND CAREER READINESS

Students enrolled at New Village Girls Academy have access to a comprehensive post-secondary planning curriculum and accompanying support. Our College and Career Center is staffed with an Academic Counselor, Learning Through Interests Coordinator, and Community Schools Coordinator and Case Manager. Through workshops and individual counseling, students develop the skills necessary to set goals and find success in life beyond high school.

PREPARACION UNIVERSITARIA Y PROFESIONAL

Los estudiantes tienen acceso a un programa completo de planificación universitaria y profesional, junto con el apoyo necesario. Nuestro Centro de Universidad y Carreras cuenta con una consejera académica, una coordinadora de prácticas profesionales, y una coordinadora de escuela comunitaria y trabajadora de casos. A través de talleres y asesoramiento individual, los estudiantes desarrollan las habilidades necesarias para crear metas y tener éxito después de la preparatoria.



INTERNSHIPS AND LEARNING THROUGH INTERESTS



We know that students learn best when they can connect their education to meaningful activities in the real world. Students spend **twice a week** in experiential internships in their areas of interest, where they obtain real-world skills and build networks that will serve them throughout their lives. Internship placement is an expectation of our curricular design, and as such is an integral part of our academic record.



PRACTICAS PROFESIONALES Y APRENDIZAJE A TRAVES DE INTERESES

Sabemos que los estudiantes aprenden mejor cuando pueden conectar su educación con experiencias reales que les interesan. Por eso, nuestros estudiantes participan en prácticas profesionales dos veces por semana en áreas que eligen. Estas experiencias les ayudan a desarrollar habilidades del mundo real y a construir redes profesionales que les servirán en el futuro. Las prácticas son parte esencial del diseño académico de nuestra escuela.





EXHIBITIONS

At the end of each semester, students are required to orally present final presentations called "Exhibitions" that will showcase the body of work they have completed in personal projects, internship projects, and classroom artifacts. Students' grades will only be released at a semester's end after an Exhibition has been presented. Parents, supportive adults, and guardians are strongly urged to attend Exhibitions!



EXHIBICIONES

Al final de cada semestre, cada estudiante debe presentar oralmente una exposición final llamada "Exhibition", donde mostrarán el trabajo que han realizado en proyectos personales, prácticas profesionales y actividades de clase. Las calificaciones solo se finalizan una vez que se ha presentado la Exhibition. Se recomienda encarecidamente que las familias, tutores y personas adultas de apoyo asistan.

TRANSPORTE

Todas los estudiantes reciben una tarjeta TAP gratuita para usar el transporte público. También pueden ser transportadas por personal escolar en la camioneta escolar o en vehículos personales de los maestros. Para salidas fuera del campus, se requiere una hoja de permiso firmada.

ACTIVIDADES DESPUES DE ESCUELA

El campus está abierto de 3:30 p.m. a 4:30 p.m. todos los días para clubes y horario de apoyo academico. **La escuela cierra a las 4:30 p.m.**

TRANSPORTATION

All students at New Village receive a free **TAP card** to use public transportation. Students are also able to be transported by school staff in the school van and in teachers' personal vehicles. A "field trip" permission slip is required for students to go off-campus.
